Motion by Patchin, supported by Tulgetske: CARRIED  
that the Board enter the Public Hearing on creating a Special Assessment District under the provisions of P.A. 81 of 1989 to provide police services to the residents of the Township.

Special Assessment roll created at 2.21 mills (\$643,570.00), the same as previous year, in which all parcels of land to be assessed are described together with the names of respective owners of record and a total amount to be assessed against each parcel. Such roll to be presented at the Regular Meeting September 12, 2017 for approval. No wage increases were sought.
