With the additional 20 acres west/adjacent to the existing park which will allow expanded recreational opportunities at the larger Municipal Park facility. New recreational opportunities may include but not limited to, a barrier free play structure, restroom building (separate from the existing Township offices) to be used specifically for the park, a dog park, pickle ball courts and adding walking trails in the new 20 acres of Municipal park.
